Follow the instructions below to learn how to care for a newly seeded lawn



Week 1

Lightly water the soil daily, at least twice a day depending on the weather. Water the area for about 20 minutes in the early morning and late evening. Try not to let the soil completely dry out. If your seed is planted in bare soil, do not soak or flood your lawn.

Weeks 2-3

Once the seed has sprouted, continue watering lightly. At this point, you should be watering your growing lawn for 10 minutes on dry or warm days. Try to allow the soil to dry slightly before watering again.

Continued Care

When the grass is a couple inches tall cut back on water, depending on the temperature. Start to cut your grass approximately every 10 days, and cut 1/3 of the height off. We recommend fertilizing your lawn two times a year (in early spring and early fall).
